

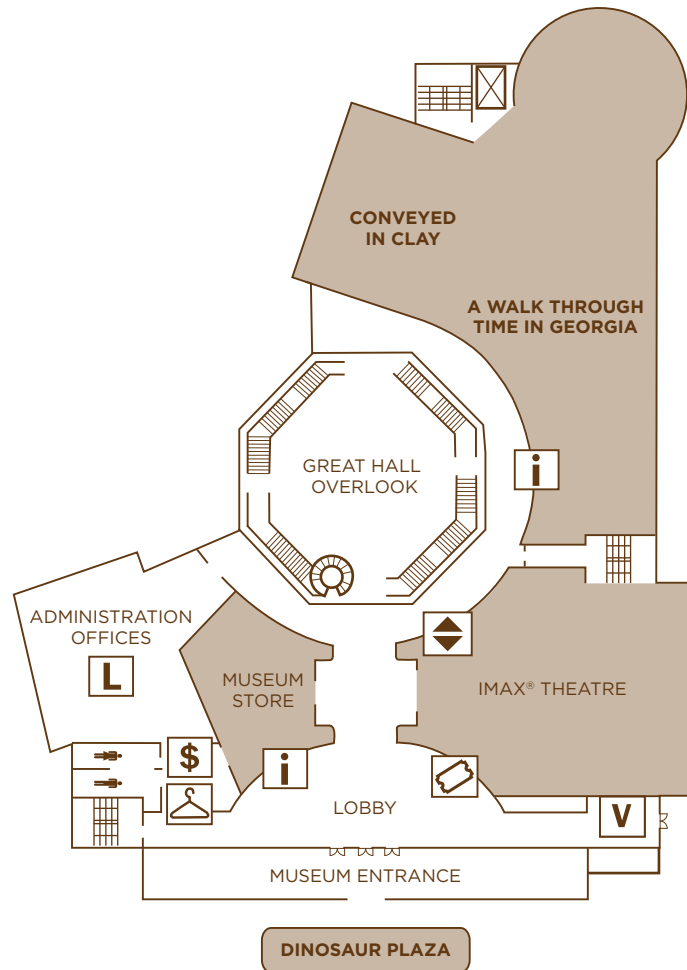
Lower Level

(Access to WildWoods and Fernbank Forest)

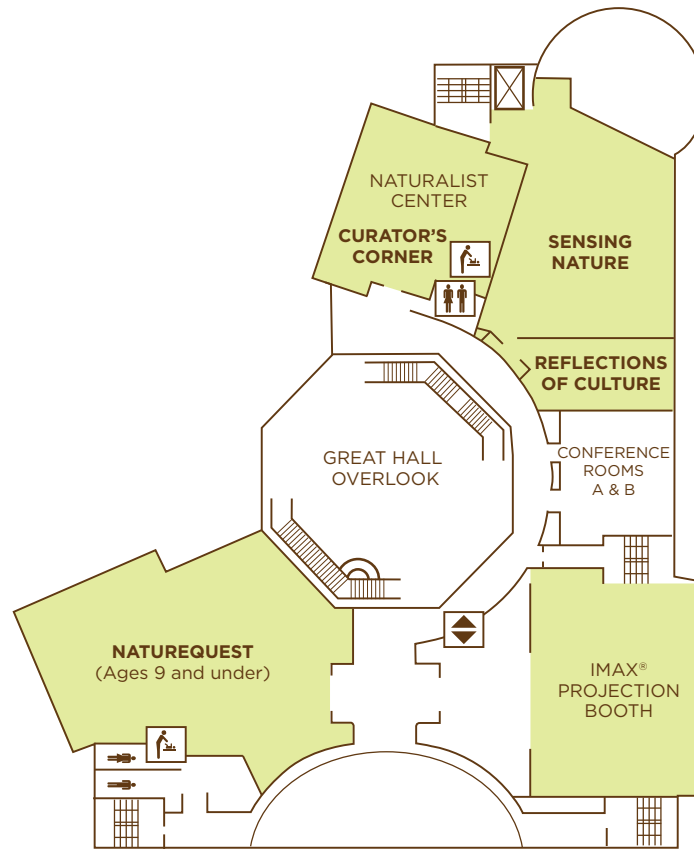


Entry Level

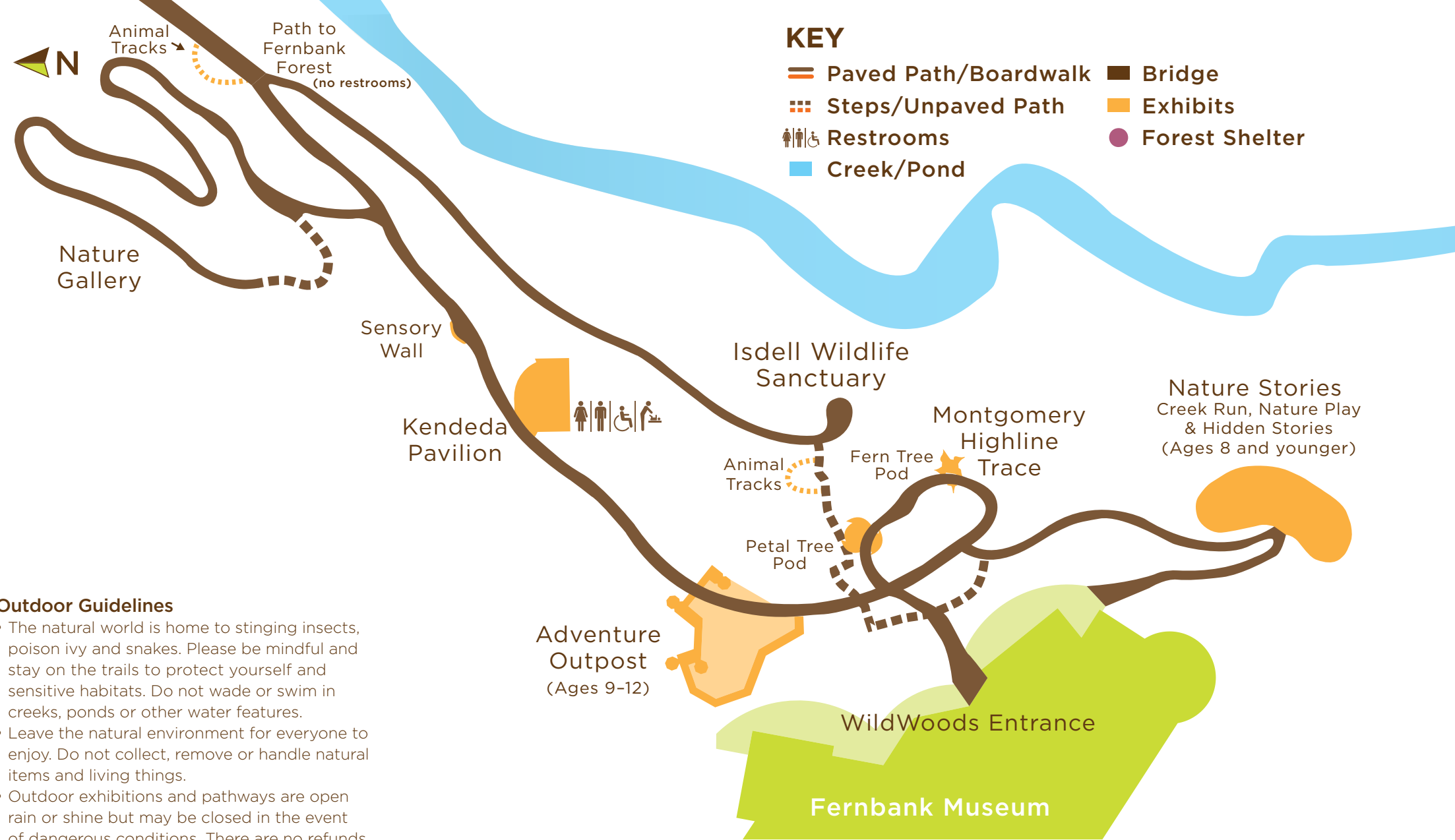

- Outdoor Guidelines**
- The natural world is home to stinging insects, poison ivy and snakes. Please be mindful and stay on the trails to protect yourself and sensitive habitats. Do not wade or swim in creeks, ponds or other water features.
 - Leave the natural environment for everyone to enjoy. Do not collect, remove or handle natural items and living things.
 - Outdoor exhibitions and pathways are open rain or shine but may be closed in the event of dangerous conditions. There are no refunds due to weather conditions.
 - Food and drinks, other than water, are not permitted in Fernbank Forest or WildWoods.



- Outdoor Guidelines cont'd**
- There are no restrooms, water or trash facilities in Fernbank Forest. Restrooms and water fountains are available inside the Museum and in WildWoods at the Kendeda Pavilion.
 - Fernbank Forest closes at 4:30pm, and the Museum closes at 5pm. For those with timed programs, including IMAX® tickets, please be aware that it takes a minimum of 10-15 minutes to walk from the Fernbank Forest gate to the Museum.
